Equivalent qualifications for registration – General Registration

Under section 53(b) of the National Law individuals are qualified for general registration if they hold a qualification considered by the Medical Radiation Practice Board of Australia to be substantially equivalent.

The 'Eligible from' date refers to the first year the qualification has been accepted. To be eligible, practitioners must provide evidence that shows that they completed their studies in the named program of study in, or after, the 'Eligible from' date.

Note: National Law refers to *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law Act 2009, as in force in each State and Territory*

Equivalent qualifications for registration – Provisional Registration

Under section 53(b) of the National Law individuals are qualified for general registration if they hold a qualification considered by the Medical Radiation Practice Board of Australia to be substantially equivalent.

Note: National Law refers to *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law Act 2009, as in force in each State and Territory*

Practitioners with provisional registration are required to undertake a period of supervised practice approved by the Board
